8. It was also resolved to continue the policy of Consultancy.














4. To set up a Women's Sports Academy to develop rural sports.









The Governing body meeting started with the welcome address by the Chairman Sri. P.N.Venkatachalam. The Chairman welcomed Dr.Meenakshi Gopinath UGC Nominee, Dr.P.S. Mohan, University Nominee, who was visiting and attending the meeting for the first time in our college campus. Dr. K.A. Chinnaraj member attended the meeting through Google meet. All the other member were present for the meeting in the college campus.

The minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved.

The Principal presented a report of the activities of the College from February 2020 to December 2020.

Dr. Meenakshi Gopinath appreciated the activities carried out by the College during the COVID-19 Pandemic through online mode.

Madam highlighted on the importance of international collaborations as we have switched to digital mode of teaching and learning and to have collaborations through the internet.

She reviewed and appreciated the Students Induction Programme conducted for 1 year UG & PG Students. Under digital inclusion she said that the alumnae can help by providing smart phones to students who cannot afford to purchase a smart phone.

She suggested for a survey on library usage, as to how many students are using digital mode of reading or the conventional mode of reading from text books. This Data would help to improve the usage of the Library. Madam insisted upon the access of e-resources also. If the college is interested in starting a new course she said to look into the availability of faculty, course content, the employment potential of a programme by doing a market survey and the need for such courses in the locality where the college is situated. The Committee Members felt that programmes like Business Analytics, Data Analytics and Cyber Security could be started as employment opportunity for these course are good.

Dr. K.A. Chinnaraj congratulated the College Management, faculty and students as the quality of activities was not compromised during these trying times too. He said that students could join the free IBM Courses like Artificial Intelligence & Personality Development.

NASSCOM has signed MOU with Government of India and Free Certificate courses are conducted and on completion of courses successfully; Certificates are issued under both NASSCOM & GOI. Any number of students can register for these courses and to analyse the possibility of such courses in the College.

Companies like TCS and Infosys are giving coaching and training to students through online mode and students undertaking these coaching classes can apply for any competitive exams conducted by the Government. He said that Practical classes can be conducted through virtual mode. The faculty and students are to be mentored to explore ways and means to exploit digital mode of teaching and learning.

They also suggest the industry institute connectivity would be better. They also suggested to record every event digitally to give text caption-content development and password to be shared. To get extension from NAAC to submit the report if there is any need.

Dr.P.S.Mohan, Syndicate member, Bharathiar University congratulated the Management, Principal faculty & students for the commendable work done during the pandemic period. He suggested to establish a digital and multimedia laboratory to get help from Dr.Thomas, Syndicate member of Bharathiar University who has established three Labs in Bharathiar University. He suggested that students can be asked to take up online courses like MOOC, Coursera and Udemty etc. A minimum of two MOOC courses with tie up can be offered.

The new education policy introduces a new landscape of learning so there will be changes in the methodology of teaching. Hence, he suggested the faculty to get trained.

The other members also requested the Management, Principal and staff to work for improving admissions and other activities of the College.

All the members actively participated in the discussion of the various agenda of the meeting and the following resolutions were passed.

1. Resolved to approve and accept the staff appointment made during current academic year (2020-21).
2. Resolved to collaborate with Central Universities and other reputed institutions for Research and Development.
3. Resolved to have more of Industry Institute interactions by inviting eminent persons from industry to address students & faculty.
4. Resolved to give continuous training to improve the teaching methods also.
5. It was also resolved to start certain Certificates course like CLISc which will provide employment from the academic year 2021-22.
