REVISED RESEARCH POLICY FOR THE PROMOTION OF RESEARCH

The existing policy of research stands revised as below:

- * Research as a component of higher education has to be strengthened with due focus on research as an integral component in the curriculum of higher education.
- ❖ A faculty member who completes research on time will be recognized during the annual day celebration with a memento.
- ❖ To motivate faculty of P.K.R to take up Ph.D., research, our college management offers research study incentive.
- ❖ Special Leave for Research 10 days (for the entire tenure) from the second year of Ph.D., registration, will be sanctioned for faculty towards completion of their Ph.D.
- ❖ Faculty members are eligible for an increment after completing a PhD in their discipline.
- Recognized research supervisors have to make sincere efforts to supervise M.Phil
 / Ph.D., candidates for the timely completion of research programmes and to develop a research culture on the campus.
- ❖ Every teacher with an M.Phil., / Ph.D., qualification has to publish a minimum of one paper every year in SCI/Scopus Indexed/UGC CARE-listed journals.
- ❖ For publishing domain-specific or inter-disciplinary articles/books, the college management will give partial financial assistance to the faculty with due approval from the Research Ethics Committee.
- ❖ For publishing a paper in an international or national journal approved by the UGC/ SCI/Scopus Indexed, the concerned author is eligible for an incentive based on approval from the Research Ethics Committee.
- ❖ Faculty members are eligible for an increment after provisionally qualifying the National Eligibility Test/State Eligibility Test.
- ❖ Initial expenses incurred by the PIs / Co-PIs for submission of project proposals will be supported by the college management.
- With the scrutiny by the Research Development Committee, the registration fees for the seminars/ conferences/ workshops attended by the faculty with proven impact for the department/ institution will incentivised.

- Financial incentive is given to the Investigator for receiving grants for seminars / webinars / training programmes / projects / any such grants from government and non-government organizations.
- ❖ A Research Forum is encouraged to be established with disciplinary and interdisciplinary research experts from regional, national and international contexts, in all research departments, for the benefit of research aspirants which shall organize research related seminar/workshop/conference/capacity building programmes/panel discussion/any such need recognized time to time, through the forum periodically.
- ❖ Call for proposals for In-house projects will be floated every year, and it is mandated for every department to complete a project. Faculty who are pursuing research, who have completed research, research supervisors and student advanced learners can apply for the scheme.
- Seed money will be awarded for In-house project investigators and to those who pursue research leading to a Ph.D.,
