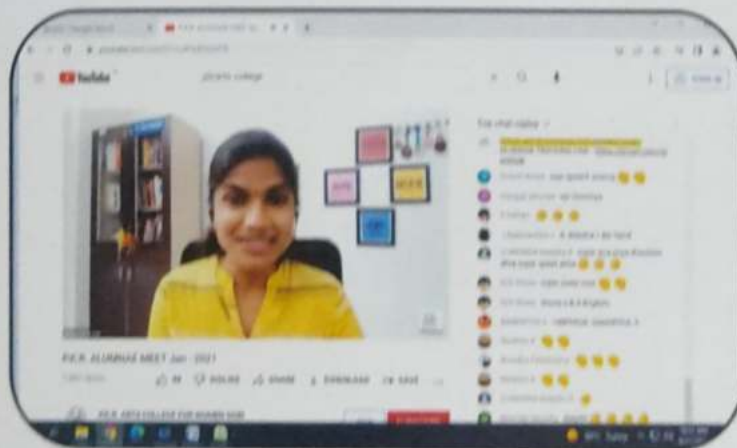

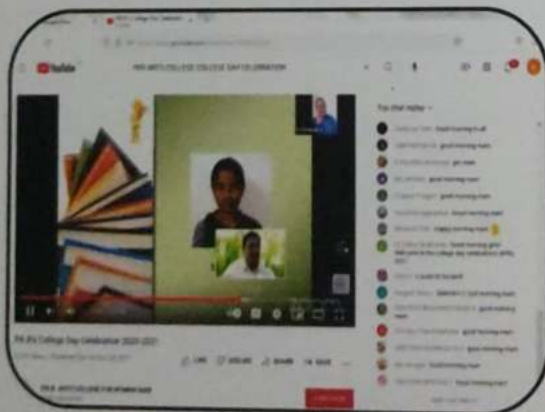

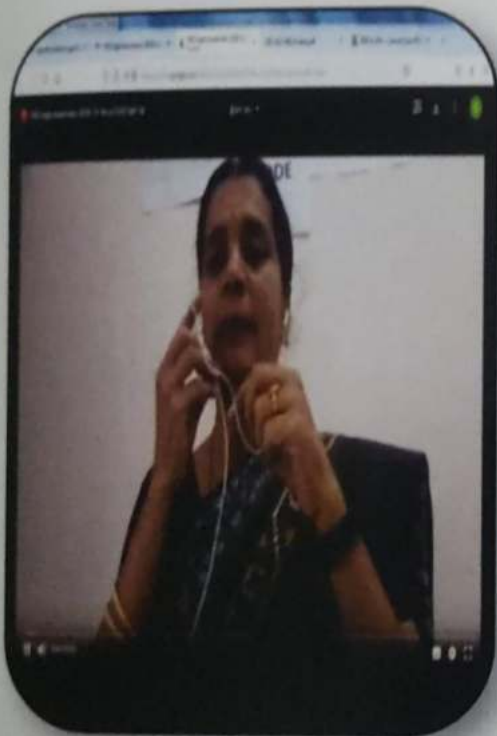

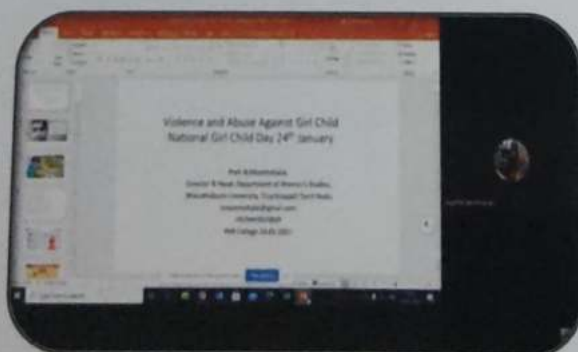


Hundiyaal Counting by NSS Students

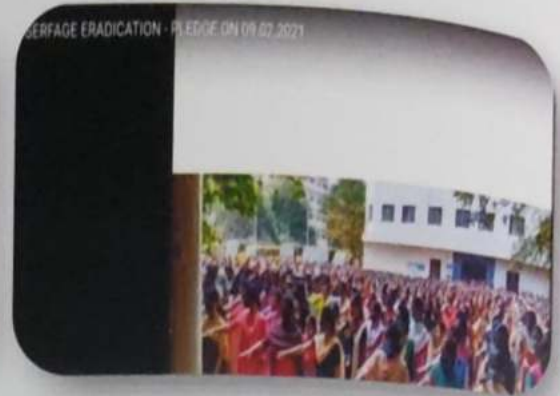


Integrity Day

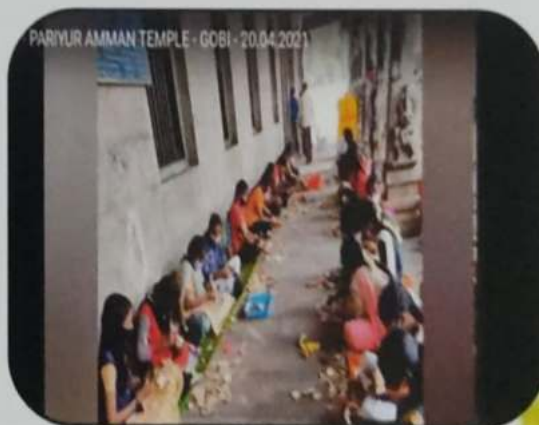
management would aid the work of conserving water resources. The Guest appreciated the students who took part in the rally.
